University of Portland head baseball coach **Chris Sperry** heads the Pilot Baseball School. A dedicated baseball teacher, Sperry's mission for PBS is to offer events that educate players of all ages in baseball fundamentals within a fun and challenging learning atmosphere. A switch-hitting infielder and catcher at UP from 1985-89, Sperry's name

appears both offensively and defensively in the Pilot record book. After having helped his club win the Pac-10 North Division in 1989, he signed a professional contract with the LA Dodgers, where he was a utility player. Since taking over as head coach of the Pilots in 1998, Sperry has twice guided UP to a second place finish. He has recruited, instructed and developed several WCC all-stars and professionals, including Kory Casto and Eric Hull, who made their major league debuts in 2007.

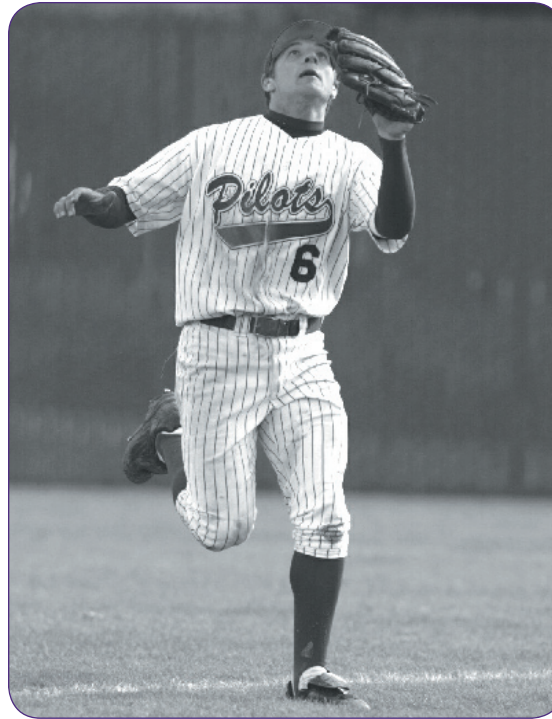

## **MID-WINTER DEVELOPMENTAL HIGH SCHOOL PROSPECT CAMP**

The Mid-Winter High School Prospect Camp from Pilot Baseball School is in its third year at the University of Portland. Designed for the serious college-bound high school baseball player, this comprehensive camp focuses on the primary defensive position of each camper, as well as hitting, base running, and strength/conditioning. In addition, information on academics, college admission, NCAA eligibility, recruiting, scholarships, and professional baseball will be shared by experts in each area. Held on the University of Portland campus, both indoor and outdoor facilities provide the training space in which high-end instruction is provided by professional coaches, scouts, and players.

## **INSTRUCTION AND EXPOSURE**

Pilot Baseball School has taken pride in its instruction for more than twenty years, and we believe we offer an instructional experience that is second to none. In addition to the skilled coaching staff and players from the University of Portland, twelve major league organizations have been represented at camp the past two years, including major and minor league players, coaches, and scouts. Campers will not only be exposed to baseball at the Division I and professional levels, but will also leave with information that can better prepare them in the classroom, as well as on the baseball field.

**What to bring:** Glove, bat, batting gloves, cup, uniform or athletic clothing, non-marking indoor shoes, outdoor shoes or turfs, wet weather practice gear, casual clothes, and spending money.

**Accommodations:** The Days Inn Hotel North is located 10 minutes away from campus and is the recommended lodging option for campers.

- Discounted rates

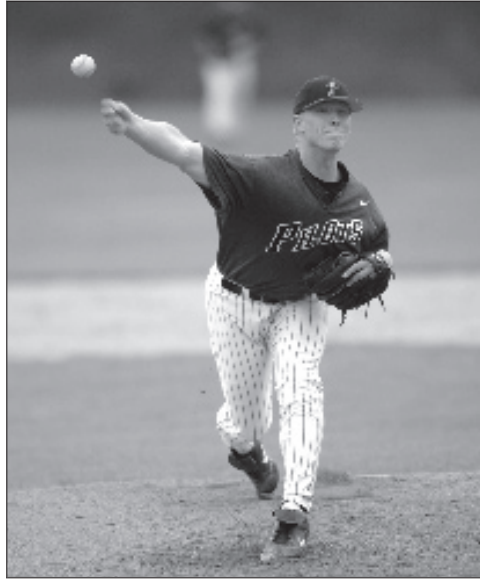
**Meals:** Full meal service will be available at the University Commons for the cost of \$100. Meal service is an

option for both commuters and out-of-town campers.

**Commuters:** Commuters will need to arrive on campus each day by 8:00 a.m. and will be dismissed by 5:00 p.m. Commuters will need to bring their own lunch unless opting for on-campus meal service at the time of registration.

**Special Notes:** Each camper is responsible for his own round-trip transportation to and from campus. Campers should check in on Dec. 26 at 7:00 p.m. at the Chiles Center. Shuttle service will be available to get campers to the Days Inn following check-in. Checkout will be at 5:00 p.m. on Dec. 30.

**Cancellations:** Refunds will be made due to illness or emergency only. A \$25 administrative fee will be reserved. To qualify for a refund, the baseball office must be notified no later than Dec. 24.
